

# **Wilmington Public Library “Build It Better” – 3D Print Challenge – Extended to Sat. Aug. 26th**

Calling all tinkerers, hobbyists, engineers and inventors. Do you think you can design it better? Remix an existing design, or design something entirely new. Submit your completed print for judging. On Saturday, August 26<sup>th</sup> all submitted 3D prints will be judged for best, most creative design. Winner will receive a package including a “Maker Select Mini” 3D printer, 3D printing class, and supplies– valued at \$350!

## **Official Rules:**

**CONTEST DATES:** 3D objects will be accepted from June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017 to 7:30p.m., Friday, August 25<sup>th</sup>, 2017. Objects must be submitted to the Wilmington Public Library, Technology Center, by 5:00p.m., Friday, August 25<sup>th</sup> to be included in the judging. Objects will be judged on Saturday, August 26<sup>th</sup> at 11:00 a.m.

### **CONTEST ENTRIES:**

-Design must be your original idea and design. Derivatives or remixes of existing designs are acceptable. 3D object must be printed out using a 3D printer. Object must be comprised of at least 80% 3D printed material. No computer files or “ideas in concept” will be accepted, only printed objects. Objects can be printed at local NCCo Libraries, local 3D print business, or online. Completed entry form (below) must be included with your submission.

**WHO MAY ENTER:** No age limit – if you can design it, we will accept it. (Contestants under 18 years old must obtain written consent of a parent or legal guardian in order to be eligible to receive any prizes.) Contestants must live or work in Delaware. One entry per contestant.

**JUDGING:** The Library will select a First Place winner based on the following criteria: creativity and printability. The odds of winning depend upon the number of entries received. In the event of any ties, Winners will be determined based in the Sponsor’s sole discretion. In all cases, Sponsor’s decision is final and binding.

**WINNER NOTIFICATION:** Winner will be notified at the Saturday, August 26<sup>th</sup> Judging. (If contestant can not be present during the judging, they will be notified via phone and email.)

**PRIZE:** One First Place winner will receive a new “Maker Select Mini” 3D printer valued at \$350. The Winner and second and third place winner will have their designs displayed on the Wilmington Public Library’s website.

**ACKNOWLEDGEMENT:** By entering in this Contest:

- Contestants agree and accept these Official Rules.
- Entry must be the creative work of the Contestant and must not infringe upon the copyrights, trademarks, rights of privacy, publicity or other intellectual property or other rights of any person and must not violate any law. Contestant assumes all responsibilities and consequences if submission is found to be otherwise. Sponsor will not be held responsible if legal action results from public exhibition.
- Contestant acknowledges that the Wilmington Public Library and sponsor will use images of the winning 3D-printed prints of the winning Designs for promotional purposes, including, but not limited to, events, marketing material, and displays.
- Winning constitutes permission (except where prohibited by law) to use Winner’s name, images, hometown, likeness, prizes won, stories, audio, video and photograph (all at Sponsor’s discretion) for future advertising, exhibition, publicity in any and all media including, without limitation, cable and broadcast television and the Internet, now or hereafter devised throughout the world in perpetuity, without additional compensation, notification or permission.
