

Driving Directions:

I 95 South: Take the Delaware Avenue South Exit 7A (Route 52) and make a left onto Delaware Avenue. From Delaware Avenue and merge onto 10th Street. Take 10th Street to King Street. Make a right onto King Street. Go three blocks down to the corner of 8th and King Streets. You will see a DoubleTree Hotel on your left. The One Customs House Building is immediately behind the Double Tree Hotel.

You can park at the metered parking spots on 8th and King Streets or go to the parking garage connected to the DoubleTree Hotel. If you park in the metered parking spots walk on the rooftop plaza behind the DoubleTree Hotel. The parking garage is to the immediate right of the DoubleTree Hotel. If parking in the parking garage connected to the DoubleTree Hotel take the elevator up to the hotel and walk to the back of the hotel. You will see the One Customs House entrance.

I 95 North: Take the Delaware Avenue Exit 7 (DE52) and make a right onto Delaware Avenue. From Delaware Avenue and merge onto 11th Street. Take 10th Street to King Street. Make a right onto King Street. Go three blocks down to the corner of 8th and King Streets. You will see a DoubleTree Hotel on your left. The One Customs House Building is immediately behind the Double Tree Hotel.



Walking Directions:

Walk to the corner of 8th and King Streets and walk on the rooftop plaza behind the DoubleTree Hotel or walk to the corner of 8th and French Streets. Take the catwalk over to the top of the parking garage and you will see the front entrance of the One Customs House.

Please bring your library card with you to enter the library. If you do not have a library card you can apply for one for free or request a (1) day pass to use the library. Please have your driver's license and proof of residency to apply for a Delaware Library Card/Day Pass.
