

Guest Pass Policy

What is required for a Guest Pass:

- 1.) People who recently moved to the area, who still have not changed their ID over to Delaware are welcome to get a guest pass using their out-of-state ID.
- 2.) Out-of-State visitors who are temporarily in the area can get a visitors pass.
- 3.) If someone has a Delaware Public Library card in the system, they are not allowed to get a guest pass, even if they have an out-of-state ID.

Patrons may get up to 5 Guest Passes. After that, we will assume that they are residents of the area and need to get a Library Card. Each guest pass is good for up to 3 hours, per day.

To obtain a Guest Pass, one of the following documents must be provided at every visit. No Exceptions.

What we will accept:

Current, Valid - Out-of-State Driver's License

Current, Valid – Out-of-state State ID

Passport (US or international)

Military ID of service men and women currently serving and away from home. (Photo ID)

Because children are not old enough to have the proper documentation, only an adult can obtain a Guest Pass. Parents may get a guest pass and sit with their child.

Any exceptions or unique situations will have to have approval from a supervisor. If the Computer Lab supervisor is not available that day, the patron will have to come back another time.
