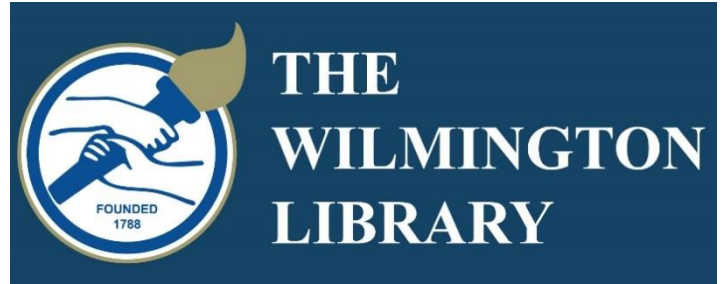

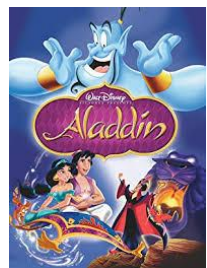

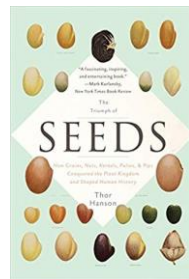
The Schools that DuPont Built, and The Schools that Redding Closed
