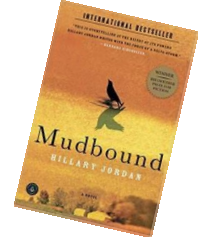

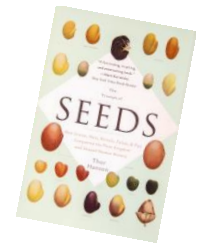


### The Role of Seeds in Society and Culture
